CARE

These are the principles we apply to achieve our stated intentions. We want to provide, so far as is reasonably practicable, a safe and healthy environment for members of the CARE, community, school, contractors and others hiring the pavilion or affected by our activities.

Therefore, whilst the day to day responsibility of managing such related issues belongs to any appointed representative at the time, the ultimate responsibility is that of the Chairperson on behalf of CARE.

Principles adopted to achieve our intentions include:

- a safe working environment especially fire safety
- safe ways of working
- systematic assessment and control of genuine risks
- maintaining and revising relevant written procedures
- ensuring volunteers and appointed persons understand those procedures
- providing sufficient information, instruction and training
- actively involving volunteers and appointed persons in all the above
